ORDINANCE NO. 0/-03

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE NOMINATION BY THE PRESIDENT IN THE APPOINTMENT BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CLERK AND THE TREASURER

THE VILLAGE OF CAMDEN ORDAINS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the express terms of MCL §62.1(3) and (4), henceforth, the offices of Village Clerk and Village Treasurer shall no longer be elected offices, but instead shall be filled by the nomination by the president and appointment by the council. The term of office of the clerk and treasurer so appointed shall be for a period not to exceed two (2) years.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Village President may submit nominations for the positions of clerk and treasurer beginning with the first term the nomination deadline for which would have been not less than thirty (30) days after the effective date of the ordinance or when the office is vacated, whichever occurs first.

<u>Section 3.</u> All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflicting portions thereof are concerned.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be published in full in the Farmers' Advance, a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Camden, said publication to be made within fifteen (15) days subsequent to the passage of this Ordinance. The Township Clerk shall promptly record this ordinance in the ordinance book of the village and such recording authenticated by the signatures of the Village President and Village Clerk.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect forty-five (45) days after the date of adoption unless a petition signed by not less than ten (10%) percent of the registered electors of the village is filed with the Village Clerk within the forty-five (45)
