## The Village of Camden Ordains that

- 1. <u>Fire Service Rates.</u> The Village of Camden may establish charges for services provided by the Camden Fire Department which are within the Camden Fire Department protection area. The amount of such charges shall be established by resolution of the Camden Village Council and shall help to offset the cost of the services provided by the Camden Fire Department.
- 2. **Procedures for collection.** The Camden Village Council shall establish the billing methods and procedures. The Secretary for the Camden Fire Department will send a bill to the individuals receiving services that are provided.
- 3. Ordinances in Conflict. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflicting portions thereof are concerned.

The Camden Village Council at it regular meeting held on April 10, 2007 adopted this ordinance. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption of this ordinance.
