RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING MAINTAINING A NUISANCE WITHIN THE VILLACE OF CAMDEN, MICHIGAN

- Sect. 1- It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, business, firm or corporation within the Village of Camden to engage in, establish, maintain, operate or continue to operate or maintain, 60 days after the Adoption of this Ordinance, any slaughter house, hog house, animal feed yard or pen, or make or permite the dispersal into the air of any noxicus fumes or foul odours, or objectionable odours or smells, or to permite to the same to be dispelled into the air, or to operate or maintain, or permit the accumulation of any pile or dump of offal, manure, garbage, trash, junk, tashes or other objectionable matter deemed as a nuisance by the Village Council.
- Sect. 2- A muisance under thos ordinance shall be; any yard, pen, building or material object, movable or immovable, which shall emit an offensive or objectionable odour, or noxious fames, or any unsightly or objectionable accumulation of offal, manure, garbage, junk, trash, cans, askes, bottles, or refuse, or anything adjudged affensive or objectionable on the grounds of health, or the general good and weldare of the people of the Village of amden.
 - Sec. 3- Any person, persons, firm, business or corporation which shall be in violation of this Ordinance, shall if found guilty, pay a fine of not less then \$25.00 or more then \$100.00 and costs, for each and every 24 hour period that such muisance shall be continued.
