PARKING ORDINANCE

It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle, truck, wagon or wheeled vehicle on the streets of Camden during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Any person in violation of this ordinance shall, if found guilty, be fined not less than two dollars (\$2.00) or more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and costs, for each and every day such violation shall be continued, and further, any such motor vehicle found on the streets of Camden during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. may be impounded by the Village Marshall or Deputy, and hauled away at the expense of the owner, and said vehicle shall be held for such removal charges and costs until redeemed by the owner within six months of the date of violation.
