AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR ON SUNDAY WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF CAMDEN

The Village of Camden ordains:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any party, firm or corporation to sell alcoholic liquor between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. midnight on any Sunday hereafter.

Section 2: The term "alcoholic liquor" shall mean any spirituious, vinous, malt or fermented liquor, liquids and compounds, whether or not medicated, proprietary, patented, and by whatever name called containing one-half of one percent (.05) or more of alcohol by volume which are fit for use for beverage purposes.

Section 3: Any person, firm or corporation violating this Ordinance shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days or a fine of not more than Five hundred (\$500) Dollars or both and shall be ordered to pay Court costs.
