**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SUBSECTION III OF ORDINANCE NO. 2017-01 OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMDEN TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM POTENTIAL NUMBER OF GROWERS LICENSES THAT MAY BE AUTHORIZED BY THE VILLAGE FROM SIX (6) TO AN UNLIMITED NUMBER OF LICENSES AND TO ESTABLISH STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR THE APPROVAL AND OPERATION OF SUCH FACILITIES, AS AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 2017-01 OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMDEN AND MEDICAL MARIHUANA FACILITIES LICENSING ACT.**

THE VILLAGE OF CAMDEN ORDAINS THAT:

Ordinance No. 2017-01 is hereby amended to provide as follows:

SECTION III.1.a

- a. An unlimited number of marihuana growers may be authorized in the Village.

SECTION III.5

5. The authorized applicant (whether with initial Application or when submitting an Application for renewal of a License) must submit proof to the Clerk that the applicant has received prequalification from the state for a State Operating License or has submitted a full application for such license. If the applicant fails to submit such proof, then such conditional authorization shall be canceled by the Clerk and the conditional authorization shall be available to the next applicant in consecutive time and date-stamped order as provided for in Section III (3) herein.

SECTION III.8

8. If a conditionally authorized applicant fails to obtain full authorization from the Village within six months from the date of conditional authorization, then such conditional authorization shall be canceled by the Clerk and the conditional authorization shall be available to the next applicant in consecutive time and date-stamped order as provided for in Section III (3) herein. The Village Council shall have authority to extend the deadline to obtain full authorization for up to an additional six months on written request of the applicant, within thirty days prior to cancellation, upon the reasonable discretion of the Village Council finding good cause for the extension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED THAT:

All remaining provisions of Ordinance No. 2017-01 not specifically amended herein shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after publication, as provided by Village Charter.
