ORDINANCE NO.1982-7. ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE MAINTAINING OF A
NUISANCE WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF

NUISANCE WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF CAMDEN, MI.
Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, business, firm or corporation to engage in, establish, maintain, operate or allow to be operated or maintained, within the Village of Camden, any slaughter house, hog house, animal feed yard or pen, or make or permit the dispersal into the air of any noxious fumes or foul odors, or objectionable odors or smells, or permit the accumulation of any pile or dump of offal, manure, garbage, trash, junk, ashes or any matter deemed objectionable and a nuisance by the Village Council.

Section 2. A nuisance under this Ordinance shall include, but not be limited to; Any yard, pen, building or material object, movable or immovable, which shall emit an offensive or objectionable odor, or noxious fumes, or any unsightly or objectionable accumulation of offat, manure, garbage, trash, junk, cans, ashes, bottles, or refuse, or any thing adjuged offensive or objectionable to the health, general good or welfare of the people of the Village of Camden. Section 3. The Village Council or their designated representative may notify in writing, any person, persons, business, firm or corporation which is in violation of this ordinance, that a violation exists and the period of time allowed by the Village Council to remove or correct the violation prior to proceeding with prosecution. In the event of a violation of this Ordinance that the Village Council deems an immediate hazard to the health or safety of the people of the Village of Camden, prosecution may proceed without written notification, and all legal actions taken to remove such hazard without delay.

Section 4. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be separable and if a word, sentence, clause or provision should be declared unconstitutional and invalid, such adjucation shall not effect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Any Ordinance or Ordinances in-consistant with the provisions hereof are hereby

consistant with the provisions hereof are hereby repealed.
Section 6. Any person, persons, business, firm or corporation convicted of a violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not to exceed 90 days and/or by a fine not to exceed \$500.00. Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect July 1, 1982.
