

UNIFORM TRAFFIC CODE

The Village of Camden, Hillsdale County Michigan hereby ordains:

1. Code Adopted. The Uniform Traffic Code for cities, townships and villages promulgated by the Director of State Police and published in the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code and in the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code and amendments as published in the Quarterly Supplement No. 5 to the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code, in accordance with Public Act 62 of 1956, State of Michigan, is hereby adopted by reference as in this ordinance modified.

2. References in Code. References in the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages to "governmental unit" shall mean the Village of Camden.

3. The Village Clerk shall publish this ordinance in a manner required by law. The public is hereby notified that a copy of the Uniform Traffic Code is available at the office of the Village Clerk for inspection by the public at all times.

4. Other ordinances in conflict here with relating to traffic are hereby specifically repealed.

5. Penalty. Every person, who is convicted of violating a provision of this code shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 and costs of prosecution or by imprisonment of not more than 90 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

This ordinance was adopted unanimously by a vote of the members present at the meeting of the Camden Village Council on May 9, 1995.
