VILLAGE OF CAMDEN

ORDINANCE 04-10

CONCERNING THE MAINTAINING OF ANUISANCE WITHIN. THE VILLAGE OF CAMDEN.

This ordinance amends ordinance dated July 13, 1965.

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person(s); business; firm or corporation to engage in, establish, maintain, operate or allow to be operated or maintained, within the Village of Camden, any slaughter house, hog house, animal feed yard or pen, or make or permit the dispersal into the air of any noxious fumes or foul odors, or objectionable, odors; or smells, or permit the accumulation of any pile of dump of offal, manure, garbage, trash, junk, ashes or any matter deemed objectionable and a nuisance by the Village Council.

Section 2: A nuisance under this Ordinance shall include, but not be limited to: any yard, pen, building or material object (movable or immovable) which shall emit an offensive or objectionable odor; or noxious fumes or any unsightly or objectionable, accumulation of offal; manure, garbage, trash, junk, cans, ashes, bottles, or refuse, or anything adjudged offensive or objectionable to the health, general good or welfare of the people of the Village of Camden.

Section 3: Dogs within the Village of Camden limits shall be deemed a nuisance under the following conditions: No dog shall be allowed to be at large at any time in the Village. No person shall permit any vicious dog of which he is the owner to be unconfined unless securely muzzled and led by a leash. Any dog shall be deemed vicious which has bitten a person or domestic animal without molestation, or, which by its actions gives indication that it is liable to bite any person or domestic animal without molestation. No person who is the owner of any dog shall permit it to be unconfined unless under the reasonable control of some person. No person shall own any dog, which by loud or frequent or habitual barking, yelping or howling shall cause annoyance or nuisance to the people in the neighborhood.

a. Any dog found at large in the Village which is doing any of the acts enumerated in Section 3 may be seized and impounded by the dog warden or any police officer.

Section 4: The Village Council or their designated representative may notify in writing, any person(s), business, firm or corporation which is in violation of this ordinance, that a violation exists and the period of time allowed by the Village Council to remove or correct the violation prior to proceeding with prosecution. In the event of a violation of this Ordinance, that the Village Council deems an immediate hazard to the health or safety of the people of the Village of Camden, prosecution may proceed without written notification and all legal actions taken to remove such hazard without delay.

Section 5: The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be separable and if a word, sentence clause or provision should be declared unconstitutional and invalid, such adjudication shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 6: Any Ordinance or Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions hereof are hereby repealed.

Section 7: Any person(s), business, firm or corporation convicted of a violation of Ordinance shall be punished by shall be punished by imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not to exceed 90days and/or by a fine not to exceed \$500.00.

Section 8: This ordinance shall take effect upon publication.
