

ORDINANCE NO 05-10

This ordinance amends ordinance no 316-66.

It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle, truck wagon or wheeled vehicle on the streets of Camden during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Any person in violation of this ordinance shall, if found guilty, be fined not less than \$75.00 or more than \$150.00 and costs, for each and every day such violation shall be continued and further, any such motor vehicle found on the streets of Camden during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. may be impounded by law enforcement and hauled away the expense of the owner, and said vehicle shall be held for such removal charges and costs until redeemed by the owner within six months of the date of violation.

It shall be unlawful for any person to park a commercial vehicle or trailer on the streets of the Village of Camden.

The definition of a commercial vehicle is:

- All motor vehicles used for the transportation of passengers or hire, goods, wares, or merchandise, weighing two and one-half (2-1/2) tons, or more, without load, or being more than twenty-two (22) feet in over-all length or having more than two (2) axles
- Trailer – All vehicles, being more than sixteen (16) feet in over-all-length, designed for carrying property or persons and for being drawn by a motor vehicle.

Exceptions to this ordinance:

- The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to commercial vehicles or trailers parked while making actual deliveries or while engaged in construction, general repair, furniture moving or other type of commercial work.

This ordinance shall take place upon publication.

This ordinance was adopted by the Village of Camden Council on December 14, 2010.

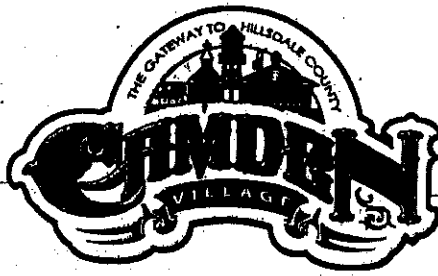

PUBLIC NOTICE

ORDINANCE NO 05-10

This ordinance amends ordinance no 316-66.

It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle, truck wagon or wheeled vehicle on the streets of Camden during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Any person in violation of this ordinance shall, if found guilty, be fined not less than \$75.00 or more than \$150.00 and costs, for each and every day such violation shall be continued and further, any such motor vehicle found on the streets of Camden during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. may be impounded by law enforcement and hauled away the expense of the owner, and said vehicle shall be held for such removal charges and costs until redeemed by the owner within six months of the date of violation.

It shall be unlawful for any person to park a commercial vehicle or trailer on the streets of the Village of Camden.

The definition of a commercial vehicle is:

- All motor vehicles used for the transportation of passengers or hire, goods, wares, or merchandise, weighing two and one-half (2-1/2) tons, or more, without load, or being more than twenty-two (22) feet on over-all length or having more than two (2) axles

- Trailer-All vehicles, being more than sixteen (16) feet on over-all-length, designed for carrying property or persons and for being drawn by a motor vehicle.

Exceptions to this ordinance:

- The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to commercial vehicles or trailers parked while making actual deliveries or while engage in construction, general repair, furniture moving or other type of commercial work.

This ordinance shall take place upon publication.

This ordinance was adopted by the Village of Camden Council on December 14, 2010.


