AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO IMMODerate riding or driving.

Passed May 22, 1899.

The Village of Camden ordains:
Section 1. Any person who shall immoderately ride or drive any horse, mule or other animal, in any street or alley within the village of Camden, or who shall ride or drive any horse, mule or other animal on any sidewalk in said, willage, shall be subject to a penalty, on conviction thereof before a competent court, in a sum not exceeding twenty-five dollars.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect June 12, 1899.
