An ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO ABATing, preventing and removing nuisances. Passed Jüne 20:1899.

The Village of Cash len ordains:
Section E. It shall not be lawful for any person or bersons to keep in or about his shop, dwelling of premests, occupied by him, any offensive annual for vegetable matter, within the linits of the village, or carry on any. filthly or footing the village, or carry on any. filthly or footing one trade or occupation that may be deemed prejudicial to health therein, and any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a penalty not exceeding five dollars for each day's continuince of such violation after being notified by the president, any trustee or the marshal, that such aritimal or vegetable matter is offensive, or that said trade, or occupation is fifthy or loutisome or prejudicial to health. Section 2. The marshal is mattenized and empowered to visit and inspect, any and call premess in the village under he finds thereon any fifthe that in this estimation constitutes a nuisance and is offensive to health, it shall be his duty to order the owner or occupant of the premess to remove the same in such time as the usual prescriber in ease such owner
