

AN ORDINANCE.

Relative To Gambling.

SECTION I.-

THE VILLAGE OF CAMDEN ORDAINS:-That no person shall manage ,use,or practice any game or devise whatsoever, with intent to cheat or defraud another.

SECTION II.:-

No person shall play for money or other valuable thing or things with cards,dice,tables,wheels of fortune, machines,billards,ten pins,or other instruments or devises whatsoever,in any hotel,grocery,eating or victualing house , store,shop,tavern,saloon,beer hall, bar room,or other building,or in any highway ,street,lane,alley,public space or square,or else where within the corporate limits of the Village of Camden.

SECTION III:-

No person shall keep,let or rent,any building or part thereof for the purpose of gaming.

SECTION IV:-

No person shall keep any dice,cards,tables,wheels of fortune,machines,or other instruments or devises, for the purpose of gaming.

SECTION V:-

No person shall keep ,maintain direct or manage or aid in keeping ,maintaining,directing or managing,any lottery or gift enterpride,for the drawing ,or disposing of money,or any other property whatsoever.

SECTION VI:-

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than fifty dollars,or by imprisonment in the Village jail,or common jail of the County,not exceeding thirty days,or by both such fine and imprisonment in the descretion of the Court, together with cost of prosecution; provided ,however,should such sentence as aforesaid,be for the payment of fine and costs, said sentence may further provide that if the same be not

paid within a certain time to be therein mentioned, the offender may be imprisoned for a period not to exceed thirty days, unless such fine and costs be sooner paid.

SECTION VII:-

This ordinance shall take effect on the 28 day of September, A.D. 1900. Passed September Fifth A.D. 1900.
