REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
APRIL 21, 2025
CAMDEN VILLAGE HALL 6:00 PM**

CALL TO ORDER: MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 6:10 p.m.

PLEDGE/PRAYER: PLEDGE RECITED BY ALL, PRAYER BY KEVIN LIGHT.

MEMBERS PRESENT: TIM DAGLOW, CARLENE SANDERSON, NATE KURTZ, BOB BATES, SARAH WILCOX, KEN DALE, KEVIN LIGHT, SHERRIE WEAKLEY (CLERK), JOYCE MCCALLISTER (TREASURER)

MEMBERS ABSENT: NONE

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: MOTION TO APPROVE MADE BY KEVIN LIGHT WITH A SECOND BY SARAH WILCOX, MOTION CARRIED.

APPROVAL OF PRIOR MONTH'S MINUTES: MOTION TO APPROVE MADE BY CARLENE SANDERSON WITH A SECOND BY SARAH WILCOX, MOTION CARRIED.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S DOCUMENTATION: MOTION TO APPROVE MADE BY KEVIN LIGHT WITH A SECOND BY CARLENE SANDERSON, MOTION CARRIED.

COUNCIL ALSO GAVE APPROVAL FOR SCOTT TO CONTACT THE MILITARY AND REQUEST A FLY OVER DURING THE NATIONAL ANTHEM AT NOON, WITH A MOTION BY CARLENE SANDERSON AND A SECOND BY BOB BATES, MOTION CARRIED.

RHONDA BACON INQUIRED ABOUT THE FENCING AT THE PARK ON CAMDEN ROADSIDE SAYING THAT SOME NEEDS REPLACING THAT IT IS IN BAD SHAPE. MIKE KURTZ REPORTED THAT THEY HAD ALREADY HAD IT QUOTED BUT THE QUOTES WERE EXTREMELY HIGH, TIM DAGLOW SAID THEY WOULD LOOK INTO IT. RHONDA REPORTED THAT THEY HAD 13 KIDS AT THE EASTER EGG HUNT AND RECEIVED 76 EGGS EACH ALONG WITH COLORING BOOKS AND CRAYONS FOR ALL.

REQUEST THE CEMETARY SAVINGS ACCOUNT ENDING IN 0205 BE PLACED IN A 13 MONTH 4.2% CD ACCOUNT. MOTION MADE BY KEVIN LIGHT WITH A SECOND BY BOB BATES, MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION TO ACCEPT A \$200 OFFER FOR THE OLD SNOW PLOW LOCATED AT THE MAINTENANCE BUILDING WAS MADE BY CARLENE SANDERSON WITH A SECOND BY NATE KURTZ, MOTION CARRIED.

TIM DAGLOW THANKED ALL COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR THE HELP WITH THE SPRING CLEAN UP, WITH A SPECIAL THANK YOU TO SARAH FOR MAKING BREAKFAST, SAYING IT WAS A SUCCESSFUL DAY GETTING RID OF 4 OVERFILLED DUMPSTERS.

A MOTION TO PURCHASE NEW TRACTOR TIRES FOR \$383.00/EACH FROM BUDD'S TRACTOR'S WAS MADE BY KEVIN LIGHT WITH A SECOND BY BOB BATES, MOTION CARRIED.

A REQUEST TO HIRE SUMMER HELP WAS TABLED PENDING A POSTING OF THE JOB, MOTION TO TABLE WAS MADE BY SARAH WILCOX WITH A SECOND BY KEN DALE, MOTION CARRIED.

SARAH TALKED ABOUT APPLYING FOR GRANTS ONE FOR THE PAVILLION AT CHESTERPARK, QUOTE PAPERWORK WAS DISTRIBUTED BY HAROLD WALKER. DECISIONS CONCERNING WHAT SPECIFICS THE COUNCIL WOULD LIKE IN A NEW PAVILLION WERE MADE PRIOR TO HAROLD BEING ABLE TO SUBMIT A QUOTE. THE SECOND GRANT WAS FOR PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT, WITH PLAN DRAWINGS SUBMITTED BY SARAH FOR TWO DIFFERENT OPTIONS. THE THIRD GRANT WOULD ADDRESS THE CEMETARY DRIVE AND TRAIL. MAY HAVE TO WAIT ON THE CEMETARY DRIVE UNTIL AUGUST TO APPLY FOR THIS GRANT. SARAH WILL CONTINUE TO WORK ON THESE GRANTS AND UPDATE ACCORDINGLY.

FIRE: EMERY REPORTED 1 BILLABLE ACCIDENT AND 0 FIRES.

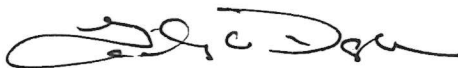

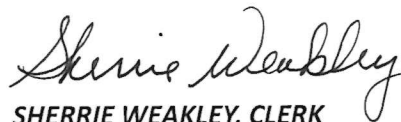
