- QUOTES FOR NEW PRINTER: DISCUSSION ENSUED ABOUT SELECTING A NEW PRINTER FOR THE OFFICE, WHETHER TO LEASE OR BUY OUTRIGHT. COUNCIL WOULD LIKE SOME MORE INFORMATION BEFORE MAKING A DECISION. MOTION TO TABLE THIS UNTIL THE NEXT MEETING MADE BY CARLENE SANDERSON, 2ND BY KEVIN LIGHT, MOTION CARRIED.
- FIRE DEPARTMENT PURCHASE OF HELMETS: MOTION TO REMOVE \$3348 FROM THE FIRE REPLACEMENT FUND TO PURCHASE 10 HELMETS FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, MADE BY KEN DALE WITH A 2ND BY CARLENE SANDERSON, MOTION CARRIED.

- FIRE DEPARTMENT INSULATION NEEDS: DISCUSSION ENSUED CONCERNING WAYS TO CUT THE HEAT BILL AT THE FIRE DEPARTMENT. MOTION TO APPROVE \$1500.00, TO COME FROM THE EXCISE TAX, FOR THE INSULATING OF THE FIRE BARN PROJECT MADE BY CARLENE SANDERSON WITH A SECOND BY BOB BATES, MOTION CARRIED.
- QUOTE FOR VALVE FOR WATER TOWER: MIKE EXPLAINED WHAT THE PARRISH QUOTE WOULD INCLUDE TO INSTALL A SHUT OFF TO ISOLATE THE WATER TOWER. MOTION BY BOB BATES TO ACCEPT THE PARRISH EXCAVATING QUOTE FOR \$20,620 TO PUT A SHUT OFF ON THE WATER TANK WITH A SECOND BY KEVIN LIGHT, MOTION CARRIED.
- HEATERS FOR THE FIREBARN. MIKE KURTZ DISCUSSED THE 4 QUOTES FOR NEW HEATERS FOR THE FIREBARN, DISCUSSION ENSUED, KEVIN LIGHT MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE BID FOR THREE REPLACEMENT UNITS FROM GRIFFITHS MECHANICAL FOR \$8347.05, COMING OUT OF THE EXCISE TAX, WITH A SECOND BY BOB BATES, MOTION CARRIED.

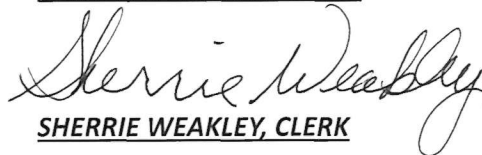

Monthly maintenance report

- Still doing a lot of miss dig tickets in town
- Water treatment plant generator serviced and found the block heater was old and quit working, had it replaced.
- The heater inside the water treatment plant went bad and quit working, had to have Griffiths mechanical install a new one.
- CorrPro came and serviced the cathodic's at the water tower
- Put in the water service and sewer service for the building on Mary St and the corner of Wales St, waiting for them to get plumbing in so we can turn the water on.
- Plowing snow
- Lift station #2 float went bad had to replace the float so the lift station worked properly.
- Having Jonesville come this week to suck LS #2 out because of the grease build up.
- Had a demo on a utility locator come out and show us how it works, problem is 85-90% of the village has plastic water mains, so his locator wouldn't be the best for the village. Did reach out to a vendor that does plastic water mains to show a demonstration waiting on him to get back into the country so we can get it scheduled.
- Have a quote from Parrish excavating to put an in-line valve at the water tower, to be able to isolate the water tower if there ever is a problem with a water main,
- Have 3-4 different quotes for new heaters in the fire dept.
