CALL TO ORDER: MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 6:05 P.M.

APPROVAL OF BUDGET: MOTION MADE BY CARLENE SANDERSON TO APPROVE THE BUDGET FOR 2025/2026 FISCAL YEAR, WITH A SECOND BY BOB BATES, MOTION CARRIED.

MEMBERS PRESENT: TIM DAGLOW, CARLENE SANDERSON, NATHAN KURTZ, BOB BATES, SARAH WILCOX, KEN DALE, JOYCE MCCALLISTER (TREASURER), SHERRIE WEAKLEY (CLERK).

MEMBERS ABSENT: KEVIN LIGHT

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: MOTION MADE BY KEN DALE TO APPROVE THE AGENDA, WITH A SECOND BY CARLENE SANDERSON, MOTION CARRIED.

APPROVAL OF PRIOR MONTH'S MINUTES: MOTION MADE BY CARLENE SANDERSON TO APPROVE AN AMENDED PRIOR MONTH'S MINUTES WITH THE ADDITION OF KEN DALE AS BEING A MEMBER PRESENT, WITH A SECOND BY BOB BATES, MOTION CARRIED.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S DOCUMENTATION: MOTION MADE BY NATE KURTZ TO APPROVE TREASURER'S DOCUMENTATION FOR MARCH, WITH A SECOND BY BOB BATES, MOTION CARRIED.

CURRENT MONTH'S ACCOUNTS PAYABLE: MOTION MADE BY NATE KURTZ TO APPROVE ACCOUNTS PAYABLE WITH A SECOND BY CARLENE SANDERSON, MOTION CARRIED.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

- MARK WILEY GAVE UPDATES FOR THE COUNTY. HE REPORTED THAT THEY ARE RECEIVING WEEKLY UPDATES ABOUT THE 911 800 MHZ UPGRADE, BOTH ENTITIES (MOTOROLA & PRYAMID) DID SITE VISITS LAST WEEK AT ALL THREE LOCATIONS. THE TIMELINE FOR THE PROJECT IS 12-18 MONTHS AFTER THEY BREAK GROUND. MARK ANSWERED QUESTIONS CONCERNING THE AMBULANCE SITUATION IN THE COUNTY. HE STATED THAT THEY ARE INVOLVED IN A CONTRACT WITH FIVE DIFFERENT ENTITIES (READING, SOMERSET, ADDISON, HUDSON, AND WALDRON). HE STATED THAT THE RESPONSE AND SHORTAGE OF PARAMEDICS ISSUE IS WIDESPREAD NOT JUST A HILLSDALE COUNTY ISSUE IT IS A NATION-WIDE CRISIS.
- ROBIN VASKO GAVE AN UPDATE ON ARTIC OCEANS SHE REPORTED THAT THEY HAVE A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR THE OLD FARMERS ADVANCE BUILDING. IT IS THEIR HOPE TO BE UP AND RUNNING IN 3 MONTHS. ON BEHALF OF ARTIC OCEANS ROBIN PRESENTED A \$5000 GOOD WILL DONATION TO HELP THE VILLAGE DUE TO THEM NOT GETTING UP AND RUNNING THIS PAST YEAR. TIM DAGLOW STATED THAT WE HOPE TO SEE SUBSTANTIAL MOVEMENT WITH THE PURCHASE OF THIS NEW BUILDING.

OLD BUSINESS:

- MOTION MADE BY SARAH WILCOX TO TABLE THE CEMETARY ORDINANCE, THE PARKS RESOLUTION AND THE MOBILE HOME RESOLUTION UNTIL NEXT MONTH, WITH A SECOND BY BOB BATES, MOTION CARRIED.
- GAS TANK ESTIMATES, MIKE PROVIDED AN ESTIMATE OF \$1510.00 AND PICTURES OF WHERE THE TANK WOULD BE PLACED. MOTION MADE BY SARAH WILCOX TO TABLE THE GAS TANK INSTALLATION UNTIL NEXT MONTH SO SHE CAN GET FIGURES TO JUSTIFY THE COST SAVINGS, WITH A SECOND BY KEN DALE, MOTION CARRIED.
- EVERYONE SIGNED ACCOUNTS PAYABLE FOR FEBURARY WITH THE REMOVAL OF A DUPLICATE ENTRY TO CARD'S TRUE VALUE.

NEW BUSINESS:

- SPRING CLEANUP, DISCUSSION ENSUED WITH MOTION MADE BY KEN DALE TO BRING IN TWO 30 YARD DUMPSTERS AT A COST OF \$750.00 EACH AND ONE 20 YARD DUMPSTER AT A COST OF \$600 EACH WITH A 20 YARD DUMPSTER ON STAND-BY TO BE PAID FOR WITH THE EXCISE TAX, WITH A SECOND BY CARLENE SANDERSON, MOTION CARRIED. THE CLEAN-UP IS SCHEDULED FOR APRIL 17TH BEGINNING AT 8:00 A.M. TIL 12:00 NOON WITH NO EARLY DROP-OFFS.

- A MOTION MADE BY CARLENE SANDERSON FOR COUNCIL TO SIGN A LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR DMCI TO BRING THE FIBER OPTIC INTO THE VILLAGE., WITH A SECOND BY BOB BATES, MOTION CARRIED.
- DISCUSSION ENSUED ABOUT PLACING THE MATCH MONIES OF \$65,000 FOR THE ROAD PROJECT FOR NEXT YEAR IN A CD, WITH THE MONIES COMING FROM THE EXCISE TAX. MOTION MADE BY CARLENE SANDERSON TO PUT THE ROAD MONEY INTO A 13 MONTH, 4.2% APY CD WITH MONIES FROM THE EXCISE TAX, A SECOND BY BOB BATES, MOTION CARRIED.
