**CALL TO ORDER:** MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 6:00 p.m.

**PLEDGE/PRAYER:** PLEDGE RECITED BY ALL, PRAYER BY KEVIN LIGHT.

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA:** MOTION MADE BY KEVIN LIGHT TO APPROVE THE AGENDA, WITH A SECOND BY CARLENE SANDERSON, MOTION CARRIED

**APPROVAL OF PRIOR MONTH'S MINUTES:** MOTION MADE BY KEN DALE TO APPROVE THE PRIOR MONTH'S MINUTES, WITH A SECOND BY CARLENE BOB BATES, MOTION CARRIED.

**APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S DOCUMENTATION:** MOTION MADE BY KEVIN LIGHT TO APPROVE THE TREASURER'S DOCUMENTATION, WITH A SECOND BY BOB BATES, MOTION CARRIED.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

MARK WILEY ADDRESSED THE ROOM CONCERNING THE TOWERS FOR THE 800 MHZ PROJECT HE SAID IT IS COMING ALONG. CONSUMERS POWER IS WAITING FOR THE TOWERS TO BE UP AND THE SHED'S TO COMPLETED BEFORE THEY BRING ELECTRICITY TO THEM. THE TARGET DATE REMAINS LATE JUNE OR EARLY JULY. BRAD BENZING AND MARK WILEY HAVE BEEN WORKING ON THE UNION NEGOTIATIONS FOR THE SHERRIFF'S DEPARTMENT AND 911. THEY ARE ALSO TRYING TO WORK ON THEIR BUDGET. MARTY TAYLOR HAS RETIRED FROM THE BULIDING DEPRATMENT, RAY TAYLOR HAS BEEN APPOINTED TO TAKE OVER.

- TIM DAGLOW DISCUSSED A QUOTE FOR THE TREE REMOVAL FROM THE CEMETERY. A MOTIONS WAS MADE BY KEVIN LIGHT TO ACCEPT THE BID FROM ZK TREE SERVICE FOR \$2750 TO TAKE OUT 4 TREES AND TRIM 8 WITH THE MONEY COMING OUT OF THE EXCISE TAX, WITH A SECOND BY SARAH WILCOX, MOTION APPROVED.

- ANTHONY MARKWORT ADDRESSED THE COUNCIL CONCERNING A NEW LICENSE FOR LETTUCE01 LLC. DISCUSSION ENSUED, MOTION MADE BY BOB BATES TO APPROVE DISPENSARY LICENSE FOR LETTUCE01 LLC, WITH A SECOND BY CARLENE SANDERSON. ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN, MOTION CARRIED.

- TWO ESTIMATES TO HAVE THE WATER TOWER WASHED WERE SUBMITTED BY TIM DAGLOW ONE FROM NATIONAL WASH AUTHORITY, LLC FOR \$8600.00, THE SECOND ONE FROM H2O TOWERS LLC FOR \$3,850.00. MOTION MADE BY CARLENE SANDERSON TO ACCEPT BID FROM H2O TOWERS FOR \$3850.00 TO POWERWASH THE WATER TOWER WITH A SECOND BY KEVIN LIGHT, WITH THE MONEY TO COME FROM THE EXCISE TAX, MOTION CARRIED.
- TIM ANNOUNCED THAT SOMEONE HAS DONATED TIME AND MATERIALS TO BUILD A NEW TOWER AT THE TRACK AT CHESTER PARK FOR THE FIRE ASSOCIATION. MOTION MADE BY KEVIN LIGHT TO GIVE THE FIRE ASSOCIATION PERMISSION TO BUILD THE TOWER FOR THE NEW TRACK AT NO EXPENSE TO THE VILLAGE, WITH A SECOND BY CARLENE SANDERSON, MOTION CARRIED, SARAH WILCOX OPPOSED.
- TIM DAGLOW REPORTED THAT THEY WOULD LIKE TO PLACE TWO NEW CAMERAS ON THE FIRE BARN FACING EAST AND WEST THAT WILL COVER THE FIREMAN'S VEHICLES AS THEY HAVE HAD ISSUES WITH VEHICLES BEING RUMMAGED THROUGH, AT A COST OF \$1200.00. MOTION MADE BY BOB BATES TO APPROVE TWO NEW CAMERAS FOR THE FIRE BARN TO BE PAID FROM THE EXCISE TAX, WITH A SECOND FROM KEN DALE, MOTION PASSED.
